January 7—**Classes Resume** after Christmas Break

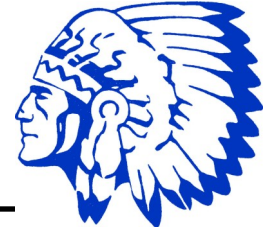
January 11—**Talent Show Sign up** forms are due.
