If you notice your child itching their head a lot, you might want to check your child's hair for lice eggs (called nits). Look for tiny, white, oval-sized eggs attached to hair near the scalp. Lice actually prefer clean hair, so they do not mean poor hygiene. Talk to your children about not sharing combs, hats, or pillows.
